- For Accident Consciousness and Behavior Safety parts, "yes" = 1, "no" / "Without this option" = -1, total scores are showed as follows.





Accident Consciousness

Can you open the security window quickly by yourself?











Questions are designed from former investigations on the frequency of indoor safety hazards.




Do you confirm that the gas switch is off before going out or going to bed?

- Again, in this part, "yes" = 1, "no" / "Without this option" = -1, but the total scores will be added up to evaluate the safety concerns over each room (or spaces that have equivalent functions, given the limited space in Hutong) of the apartment.
- The higher the score is, the more attention senior citizens are paying attention to. In *Bedroom* and *Study Room* part, questions are subdivided because from our literature review, we have found that most of safety hazards happen in bedrooms.

Interviews are conducted in two families of Hutong.



- ✓ Female
- √ 75 years old
- ✓ Living with her husband and son/daughter
- ✓ Activities freely, articulate, positive and good temper, good thinking ability, communicate fluently



- ⊗ Poor lighting.
- They use gas but don't have alarm device.
- Tile floor in the room.
- Granny has trouble on washing her face due to her weak waist.



- ✓ Female & Male
- √ 90 years old
- Living with her/his partner and son/daughter
- ✓ Activities freely, articulate, positive and good temper, good thinking ability, communicate properly with others
- Nothing protects them when having bath.
- No public toilet had equipped the certain seat and hands for the old people, but it was an acceptable situation though a bit inconvenient.
- The most serious problem for these interviewees is not the space safety.
